



Child Protection Improvement Plan Multi Agency Staff Engagement Events

Wednesday 12th May 2010 and Friday 21st May 2010

Al-Maktoum Institute, Dundee

The views, involvement and co-operation of the personnel who work in Child Protection services are critical to the development and implementation of the Child Protection Improvement Plan. The Chief Officer (Care & Protection) Strategic Group continue in their commitment to supporting the programme of Staff Engagement Events which commenced in November 2009.

The response from those who attended in November has informed the planning of these forthcoming events. Each of the dates in May has a different emphasis and you should identify which of the events you, or relevant representatives from your organisation should be involved in. You may want to contribute to both.

Both dates will commence 9.00am for 9.15am start, finishing at approximately 4.30pm. Lunch will be provided. More detailed programmes for each day will be circulated prior to the event along with any supporting documentation.

Wednesday 12th May 2010

This day is aimed directly at front line staff and first line managers who undertake and are responsible for key protection processes such as referral, assessment, investigation and intervention.

There will be an update on progress with the Implementation Plan and responses to the issues that the participants raised at the November events. The focus will be on the role that you, your teams and your agencies have in the implementation of improvements and your feedback on the impact of the Improvement Plan to date. There will also be an input from the locality based Local Practitioner Forums.

Friday 21st May 2010

This day will also have an update on progress with the Implementation Plan but the main emphasis of the day will be on everyone's role and responsibility in self evaluation and the Multi Agency Self Evaluation Framework. There will be an introduction to recent developments such as a Practice Review Sub Group, Scrutiny Group and multi agency case file audit processes.

The input of front line staff is also central to this event, but there is a particular relevance for the attendance of personnel in all agencies who have a specific role or responsibility for undertaking self evaluation in their respective organisations.
